MATHS

This half term, Year 5 will be looking at; Calendars, timetables and calculators, factors and multiples, mental and written addition and subtraction, positive and negative numbers and symmetry, reflection and coordinates.

Year 6 will be ratio, percentages and proportion, time and money, algebra, comparing and ordering numbers, fractions, decimals and percentages and geometric shapes.

As always, we will continue to focus on mental strategies throughout the term.

SCIENCE

This half term, we will be looking at Life Cycles.

We will be looking at reproduction in plants, both sexual and asexual. We will also compare the life cycle of an animal in our local environment with animals around the world. We will finish the topic by comparing how different animals reproduce and grow and looking at the work of naturalists.

GEOGRAPHY

This half term we will be travelling to North America, identifying the states and capital cities within North America, the climate and human and physical features before comparing a city in North America to a city in the UK. We will also be looking at The Grand Canyon.

We will start the half term off by recapping Safety and Online safety.

We will then move on to thinking about and exploring the types of jobs would we like.
